Activities include creating training materials and conducting presentations, developing and adhering to an annual action plan, submitting continuation application, employing CADCA's evidence-based strategies for community change, coordinating other related grants such as the Local Prevention Council grant and CT State Opioid Response grant that support the mission and goals of the Coalition.
