SUBJECT: Bi-Weekly Report of Significant Police Related Incidents, 12/10/2018 – 12/30/2018

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide you with a brief summary of significant police related incidents and issues between 12/10/2018 – 12/30/2018. It also includes highlights of certain planned events occurring over the next several weeks.

Year to date, overall Part 1 Crime in 2018 is down by 116 incidents, or -11.2% compared to the same period in 2017. This includes an increase in Violent Crime of 7 incidents or +11.1% and a reduction in Property Crime of 123 incidents or -12.6%.

Major Incidents

20181218-1252-07: Suicide @ 8900 block Northpointe Executive Pk.

Officers responded to a deceased person. It was determined the victim died from a self-inflicted gunshot wound.

20181220-0859-02: Overdose @ 8700 block Twin Trail Dr.

Officers responded to a subject who overdosed on an unknown substance. The subject was transported to the hospital for further evaluation.

20181221-2311-07: Robbery @ 14300 block Reese Blvd. (Jimmy Johns)

The suspect entered the restaurant wearing a mask and brandishing a firearm. The suspect demanded money then fled in an unknown direction.

20181225-0915-02: Aggravated Assault @ 10500 block Kerns Rd.


Officers responded to the listed address reference to the victim advising the suspect attempted to hit them with a vehicle.

20181226-1022-05: Murder @ 11900 block Bryton Pass Ln.


Officers responded to a report of Assault with a Deadly Weapon. Officers arrived on scene and found one victim deceased from gunshot wounds and a second victim with a single gunshot wound. The second victim was transported to the hospital.

Traffic Stops



Year to date, there have been 2,087 traffic crashes in the Town of Huntersville. This represents a +5% increase when compared to the 1,982 traffic crashes that occurred during the same period in 2017.

Year to date, police officers have conducted 8,784 traffic stops in the Town of Huntersville. This represents a +6% increase when compared to the 8,296 traffic stops conducted by officers during the same period in 2017.

The majority of the traffic crashes in 2018 occurred near Gilead Rd and I-77, as well as Sam Furr Rd and I-77. Driver inattention, traffic congestion and speed continue to be among the main factors contributing to the traffic crashes
