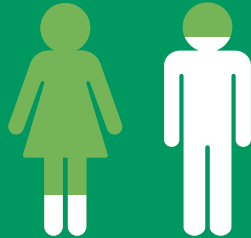

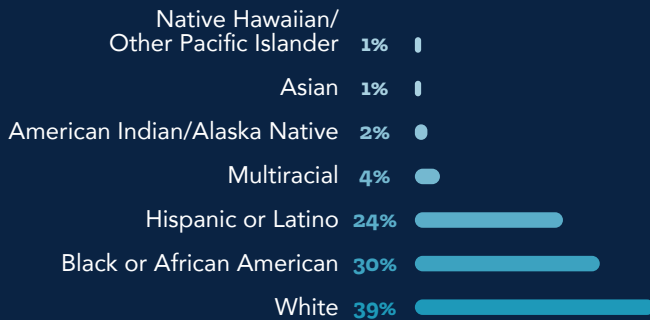

# BuildStrong Academies

In 2023, HBI opened two new construction training Academies in Phoenix and Sacramento. HBI's Academies represent a new learning environment that delivers industry-recognized skills training to a new generation of home builders. The Academy offers tuition-free construction career education through hands-on learning, classroom teaching, and real-life experience. Students gain hands-on technical skills and practical knowledge in basic construction fundamentals, job readiness, discipline and confidence, and access to resources that will prepare them to build a career and successful livelihood.

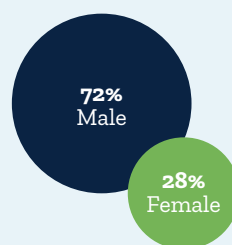

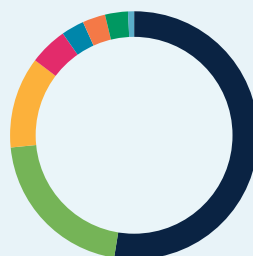
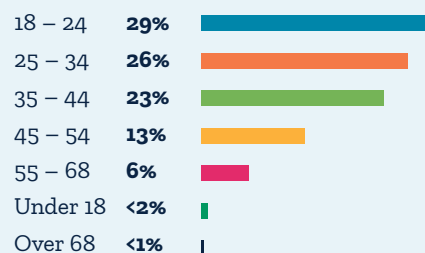

# Job Corps

In 2023, the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL) awarded HBI a new five-year contract. HBI prepares students with the skills and experience they need for successful careers through pre-apprenticeship training, job placement services, mentoring, certification programs, textbooks and curricula. Job Corps provides students with an opportunity to transition from low-income jobs to careers that provide families with sustaining wages.



Operates on **67** centers across the country.



HBI was awarded **6** new programs to our contract, including our first Advanced Training Plumbing program.



HBI is currently exceeding the 30% Apprenticeship/Union Placements of Job Corps graduates at **32.73%**



The Apprenticeship hourly wage of **\$18.64** is also exceeding the DOL goals.



2052 students entered our programs and 1145 completed. We placed **94.1%** of our completers and **86.7%** of them in the industry. Our average wage was **\$18.73**

I'm grateful for all the opportunities that HBI gave me, now my road is even longer. With Faith Technology, I have the position of a traveling Electrical Apprentice. This opportunity allows me to see new states, new people, new mentors and have a strong education. # Community Programs

Working with local organizations, HBI customizes programs for underserved and underemployed populations. The Community and Corrections Programs finished 2023 with the most improvement. HBI has enhanced the program deliverables to provide a better experience for the students we serve.

## Transitioning Military

With the support of the Home Depot Foundation, HBI trains at 10 military bases around the country. The Military Services Programs ended 2023 by serving the most students in a single year since they were established. Since launching in 2018, the placement rate topped 90% and the average starting wage was the highest it has ever been. HBI has celebrated 787 graduates from the 2023 cohorts and the programs are on track for the highest number of graduates yet for 2024.

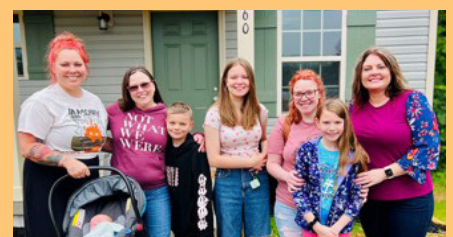
