Grand Blvd in St. Louis by October 30. For example, a church would need to take all of the choir robes and stoles, rather than the robes, but not the stoles, or vice versa.

- ◆ Complete communion set made of chrome with 8 juice trays and 8 bread trays, 2 covers and 2 bases for the juice trays, and 2 covers for the bread trays. It looks like one of the juice trays is dented, but the set is otherwise in good condition. Here’s a picture of a couple of the juice trays, with a base and a cover, and some of the bread trays with a cover.



- ◆ A brass cross that can be placed on a worship or communion table. Roughly 14 inches tall. Here's a picture.



- ◆ Choir robes in good condition. 15 total in various sizes. Royal blue, washable. Each robe has a set of 2 reversible stoles in liturgical colors (purple and red on one stole, white, and green with a white border on the other). Here are pictures.



- ◆ Assorted paraments for pulpit and lectern covering all liturgical seasons. Most are in good condition. Here are some pictures.





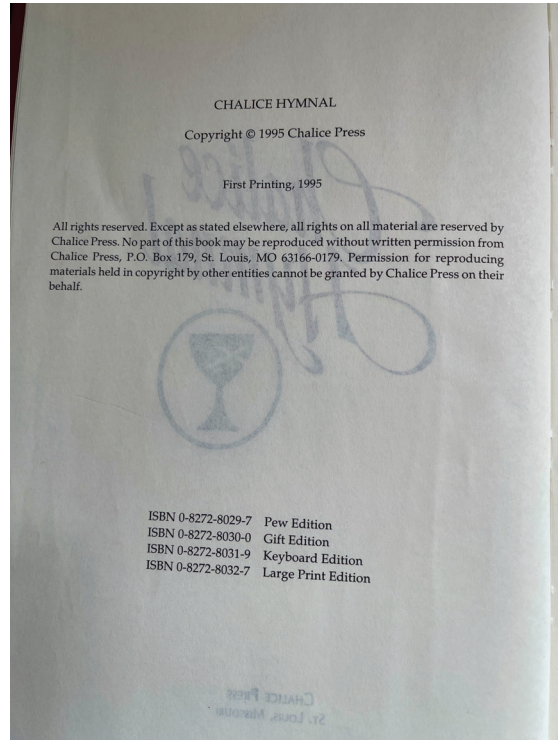
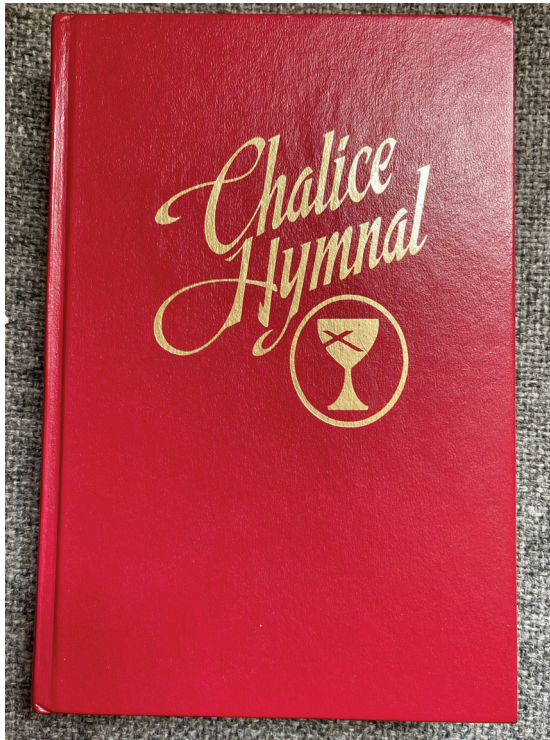
- ◆ Three baptismal robes in various sizes—here's a picture.
