Volunteers at Calvary Women's Services

provide invaluable services to residents, but they also gain something valuable in return from the relationships they build and the meaningful work they do. Our staff schedule volunteers based on their availability, interests, skills and where there is a specific need. Below is a list of current volunteer opportunities.

LEAP Facilitators

LEAP Facilitators are passionate volunteers who lead classes for 8-10 residents on weekday afternoons. Each class lasts for eight weeks. The class topics range from budgeting to geography to self-advocacy! Every LEAP volunteer is matched with a class that fits their passions and skill sets.

Job Placement Program Facilitator

The Job Placement Program (Step Up DC) Facilitator allows 4-6 program participants to access the computers on Tuesday and Thursday mornings. Facilitators should have enough computer experience to log participants onto computers, monitor computer use, and answer any questions that may arise related to online job searching and technology.

Job Fair Transportation Volunteer


The Job Fair Transportation Volunteer accompanies clients to local job fairs as part of Calvary's job placement program (Step Up DC). Volunteers will meet clients at Calvary, help prepare them for the job fair, then accompany the clients (via public transit or Uber/Lyft) to the job fair. Volunteers are expected to make an ongoing commitment to join clients for four job fairs in a year.

Step Up DC Employment Task Force

The Step Up DC Employment Task Force is a group of 2-3 committed volunteers who help increase job opportunities and community relationships on behalf of Calvary's job placement program (Step Up DC). Task Force members research employment opportunities in the community and reach out to employers encouraging them to hire applicants from Step Up DC.

Meal Volunteers (Saturday Breakfast)

Meal volunteers provide a nutritious home-cooked breakfast to brighten a resident's day with a hot meal and a warm smile. Saturday breakfast volunteers prepare a meal at home for 30 residents and bring it ready to serve at 6:30 am on Saturday mornings. This is a great volunteer opportunity for individuals and groups of up to 12 volunteers. We ask groups to cover at least three meals a year.
