- **Student submissions are automatically entered to compete for the *Outstanding Poster Awards*, which includes monetary awards for the top three posters.**
- **Young Professional submissions are not eligible for an *Outstanding Poster Award*.**

Poster content should describe novel research topics preferably relevant to the symposium's theme, *Smart Water Systems of Today – Cyber Innovations in Water Systems*. **Topics may include -- but are not limited to:**

- **Smart water networks and big data in water planning and management**
- **Novel sources of data for assessing water risk and scarcity**
- **Advanced metering infrastructures**
- **Water usage analysis using Automatic Meter Reader (AMR) data**
- **Wireless and remote sensor networks**
- **Technologies for resilient and efficient smart water networks**
- **Smart water management of agricultural, urban and residential systems**
- **Water network partitioning**
- **Emerging research in new data sources, sensors and big data**
- **Emerging research for the IoT and modeling of smart water networks and management**

POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

EASEL STAND. Each poster will be provided with an easel stand. Presenters are NOT required to bring their own stands.

POSTER BOARDS. The presenters are REQUIRED to provide board mounted posters or poster boards for mounting their posters onsite. Simple supplies (tapes and pushpins) will be provided onsite. For easier transportation, the recommended standard size for poster boards is 24 inches X 36 inches. However, full size poster boards (36 inches X 48 inches, or two 24 X 36 taped together) are allowed and can be supported with the same easel stand. (Exception: Out of town travelers who are flying in may contact us to make special arrangement for you.)
