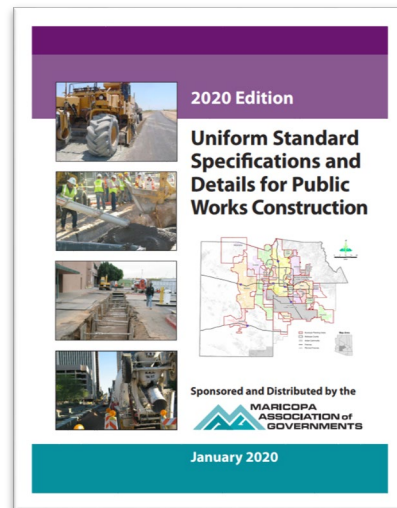
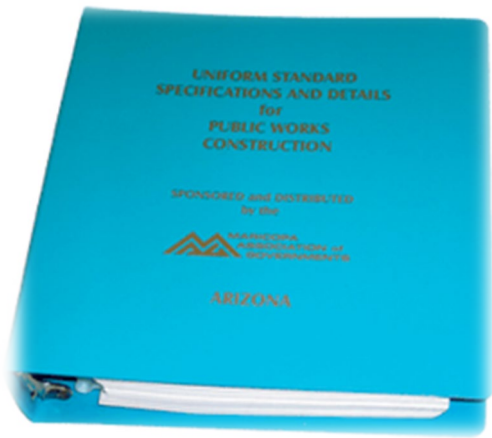


Sustainable Cities Network is Seeking Volunteers to Update MAG's Landscape and Irrigation Standards and Details!



Who: All sectors are welcome—municipal/agency staff; NGOs; and landscape architects, irrigation designers, landscape contractors, construction services specialists, and specifiers

What: MAG's Landscape and Irrigation Standard Specifications and Details have not been modified in decades. A **Landscape Working Group** is being formed to update Sections 425, 430, 440, and 795 of the Standard Specifications plus the Standard Details. The Working Group will also develop standards for installations on private properties outside of public rights of way.

Anticipated Schedule

- Kick off meeting by **11/2020**
- Identify potential update items **11/20 – 1/15/21**
- Recommend modifications **1/15/21 – 4/15/21**
- The work will involve **monthly coordination meetings** and individual technical contributions and specification and design detail editing through the standards development process.
