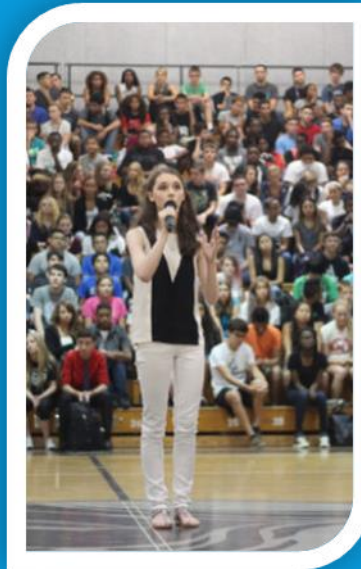
IB FAQ'S
