VENUE & DRESS CODE

The Old Stone Farm House Restaurant is situated in a 200-year old, restored plantation field house overlooking the Mahogany Run Golf Course. The stone walls, archways, shuttered windows, and lovely courtyard with fountain resound with the history of this estate. Once, the 300-acre plantation stretched from Magen's bay to Mandahl. More than two centuries ago the Old Stone Farm House was the core of a Danish sugar plantation at Estate Lovendahl. The graceful arches, two- foot-thick walls and majestic rafters are reminiscent of St. Thomas during the days of the flourishing Clipper Ship trade, sugar plantations on lush rolling hills and the aristocratic mansions of prosperous merchants.

Today this magnificently converted farm building is an excellent example of restoration. This is considered one of the best examples of classic West Indian architecture on the island. Native blue bit rock and brick and rubble masonry are the prime construction materials.

The venue will be transformed into an elegant poker tournament for the event. With professional grade poker tables that hold ten players per table and a dealer. Valet parking will be available at the location.

**These winnings must be reported and will be taxed as is required by the United States of America gaming winnings tax laws.

When players pay their buy-in fee, they will receive an official digital tax deductible receipt for the value of the event.

Refund & Switching Players

There will be no refund once player pays the tournament buy-in. Players will be allowed to give their seat to another player if they are unable to come to the tournament. Player must notify the Executive Game 48 hours prior to the tournament for a valid player seat transfer to be allowed. Original player must provide new player's name and contact information.

NOTE Players must pay the \$5,000 up front in order to reserve their spot for the tournament. **All player payments are due by Friday, January 24th, 2020.**

NOTE Spectator pass purchasers will receive a tax deduction receipt based on the value of the event. This value will be determined at a date closer to the event.



TOURNAMENT & EVENT AGENDA

- Players and their guests can enjoy cocktail hour starting at 3:00 PM at Old Stone Farmhouse
- Tournament will start at 4:30 PM sharp and the duration is approximately six hours based on the players starting stack and blind schedule
- Spectators can arrive at 6:30 PM to enjoy the rest of the evening

NOTE The Executive Game has the right to adjust the agenda as seen fit.



TOURNAMENT RULES

Starting Chip Stack

Every player starts with 15,000 chip stack.

Blind Structure & Schedule

Blinds will be 20 minutes in length. There will be a break every hour. The first break will be 15 minutes, all remaining breaks will be 10 minutes.

Play is expected to last between 5 and 7 hours until a winner is determined. Blind schedule to the right.

Rebuys

- Players will have the opportunity to rebuy one time, prior to the end of the 2nd break. There will be an announcement prior to the expiration of the eligibility for rebuys.
- Player must be completely out of chips to rebuy.
- Players will be required to pay for their rebuy with check or PayPal money transfer. Cash is not permitted.

Tournament Etiquette

The Executive Game 501(c)(3) Rules were created to mirror the key rules and etiquette of the World Series of Poker (WSOP) and other prominent poker clubs.

NOTE Player must have valid ID at tournament to play.
Player must be at least 18 years of age.

APPENDIX

OFFICIAL RULES & ETIQUETTE

These rules govern the operation of all players in any Executive Game 501(c)(3) sanctioned event. When in doubt Tournament Director will make all final decisions.

1. All players must agree to and abide by all the Executive Game 501(c)(3) Rules and **Robert's Rules of Poker** – Version 11 (any modifications listed below). For “game specifics” see **How To Play Texas Hold'em**.
2. Players must be at least 18 years of age.
3. Players must have a valid ID to prove they have already paid and are at least 18 years of age.
4. The tournament is open to amateurs as well as professionals.
5. Players who do not follow the rules, will receive a verbal notice, penalty, then removed from the event if the behavior continues.
6. No weapons of any kind are allowed.
7. Gambling, cheating, stealing or placing currency on the poker table IS NOT allowed and those caught engaging in these acts will be banned from current and future events.
8. Excessive use of profanity or obscene language, causing a disturbance by arguing, shouting or making excessive noise is not allowed and those caught engaging in these acts will be warned once. If disrespectful behavior continues, the player will be disqualified and asked to leave the event.
9. Throwing, tearing, bending, crumpling cards or chips is not allowed and those caught engaging in these acts will be subject to penalties or removal from the event.
10. All Tournament Director decisions are final.
11. Players will be given a random seating card at the start of the tournament for their starting seat.
12. At the beginning of the event, the dealer button will be decided by dealing high card at one table. That seat is then the button at each table.
13. Chips must remain on the poker tables always, with the highest denomination chips clearly visible. If a player needs to relocate to another table, they must carry their chips or may be given a tray if needed. Chips must remain visible at all times. Players may not place chips in their pockets, purses, etc.
14. Players who are not at their seat for an entire blind level will be removed from the tournament. A player must play at least one hand per blind level to have their chips remain in play. Blinds will be continued from the players stack as if the player is present.
15. Dealers may fold your cards if you are not at the table when it's your turn to act.
16. Using your cell phone at the table is absolutely prohibited. If you have an emergency call or text, you must leave the table and if it is your turn the dealer may fold your cards.
17. Announce bets or raises clearly. No string bets allowed. Do not splash the pot.
18. An oversized chip bet is a call, unless previously declared a raise.
19. Raises must be at least the amount of any previous raise (or bet), except when all-in.
20. Players must show both of their cards to win a contested pot.
21. Side pots will be used when necessary.
22. ANY player who is last to act that ‘checks’ an indisputable winning hand (the nuts), will be subject to a penalty.
23. If Player 1 exposes their live cards to another player still in the hand, this would be considered collusion and Player 1's hand would be declared dead.
24. If Player 1 shows their live cards to Player 2 (who has folded) then any player may request to see Player 1's cards and Player 1 must show their cards to requesting player(s), after the hand is complete.
25. Blinds will be raised throughout the tournament according to the blind schedule provided in this document. Players are obligated to pay all blinds in turn.
26. Dead Button: If the player in the small blind is eliminated, the button moves to the empty seat. Players post blinds as normal.
27. Dead Small Blind: If the player in the big blind is eliminated, the small blind is dead and only the big blind is posted.
28. If two players are eliminated on the same hand, the player who started the hand with more chips is awarded the higher finish position.
29. Button will be redealt when tables are consolidated and when the final table is reached. Tournament Directors discretion.
30. When two players remain, the player due to assume the big blind does so. The player in the small blind gets the button and acts 1st prior to the flop & 2nd after the flop.
31. Smoking (or vaping) at the table and inside the venue is absolutely prohibited. Smoking is allowed outside the venue in a designated area.
32. In order for a cash prize “chop” to be reached between the final two players, all players involved must agree to the chop.
