Needs to be on your website:

- 1) Prohibited Conduct Policy – with your association name on policy
- 2) One on One Policy – with your association name on policy

SAFESPORT TRAINING-

- 1) Board members and employees need to have current SafeSport training certificate and screening – Track and have on hand if audited.
- 2) For all teams that allow u18 players, every player 18 or over and all adults who have authority over the u18 player need training and screening.
