

2024 Child Abuse/Neglect Data


For the calendar year of 2024, there were 55 removals of children in Boone, Colfax, Nance and Platte Counties. There were 296 accepted Intakes to the CPS/APS Reporting Hotline in 2024 for a total of 764 children.

Removals for the area covered by Community and Family Partnerships have increased between 2023 and 2024.




2024 Child abuse/neglect data-Does Not Meet Definition

For the Intake calls for the counties covered by Community Family Partnerships that were closed as Does Not Meet Definition, most of those calls had allegations of physical neglect. The table on the next page breaks down the calls into allegation category.




The table below provides the list of reporter sources for the calls closed as Does Not Meet Definition. Educational Personnel is the primary reporter source. A chart is also provided on the following page.


