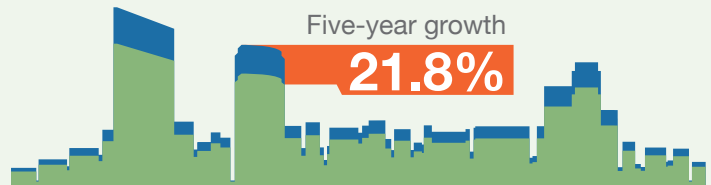

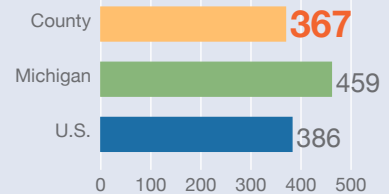
In 2018, the senior millage will provide **\$10.3 million** in funding for **51** unique services for older adults
