SACRED SITES TOUR - DON'T MISS THIS SPECIAL OPPORTUNITY, MAY 18, 9:00 AM-3:00 PM

Tour of three local sacred indigenous sites led by Jim Bear Jacobs (Mohican), the Program Director for Racial Justice for the Minnesota Council of Churches. The intent of the tour is to learn about Minnesota history from the Native perspective, through silence, meditation, reflection, and hearing stories. We will board a bus together to take us from site to site: Fort Snelling State Park, Dakota internment camp following the Dakota-U.S. War, and Pilot Knob Hill, a traditional burial ground.

Cost: \$20/person. Includes bus and tour fee. Bring your own lunch and beverage. Though not appropriate for young children, we encourage high school age and above. (Perhaps for independent learning credit?)

Sign Up Before May 1: The maximum number of participants is 50, and we need 50 to keep the cost at this level. Open now to Judson members and friends. On May 1, registration will be opened up to Trust Churches and the Kingfield neighborhood.
