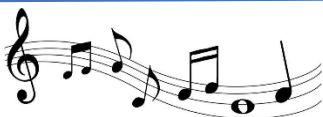
#### **BRIGHT FUTURE REPORT**

Our next two "Bright Future" forums are on the second Sunday of July and August (July 14 and August 11). These forums will provide a foundation for long-term planning, which will occur between September 2024 and January 2025.
