- A church partnering with the community to provide a thanksgiving meal to 300+ people
- The addition of a worship service for people with dementia
- A youth group creating opportunities for persons with special needs to interact with those who do not have special needs
- A congregation that decided to house a Muslim family in the parsonage
- A four-church effort to provide money and supplies for people to have clean laundry weekly
