On October 13 and 14, First Congregational UCC Menomonie honored Indigenous Peoples Day by hosting members of Ho-Chunk UCC to engage the church in the “Blanket Exercise.” This exercise is a telling of North American indigenous peoples’ history from the fifteenth century to present day. The exercise is participatory--the blankets show the size and population of indigenous people in North America from the time of European explorers and how and why they diminish over the next 500-600 years.
