You are welcome to drive yourself to each event. DTS Fluid Power builds and repairs hydraulic components for large mining and drilling equipment. These machines are among the largest in the world. We will see large lathes, mills, tear down and test benches as well as unusual welding processes during our visit to their facility.

Moderate to Difficult Hike - Bridal Veil Falls 4501011_02 (trip is full – get on the waitlist)

The hike to the top of Bridal Veil Falls starts at a large parking area just past the Pandora Mill at the east end of Telluride. We will follow the dirt and gravel jeep road as it switchbacks up the northeast wall of the dramatic box canyon at the head of the Telluride valley. Colorful eroded canyon walls loom overhead while in the distance Bridal Veil Falls, Colorado's tallest free falling waterfall, plunges 365-ft. from just beneath the Bridal Veil power plant.

Distance: 4.0 miles (RT), Elevation: 9,020-ft. at Trailhead, Maximum elevation - 10,400-ft.

Elevation Gain: 1,380-ft., Difficulty: Moderate (Difficult for some due to the elevation gain)
