Overview

This course provides adult education practitioners, prison partner staff, parole and probation partner staff, and workforce system partner staff with an overview of evidence-based reentry resources and best practices for working with offenders and reentrants. Small group activities during the training and collaboration with community partners after the training will equip participants to provide services that align to the Local Workforce Development Area Plan initiatives to reduce recidivism and increase successful transitions to self-sufficient employment for offenders and reentrants.

Format

This is an online course with three live webinars. Participants are encouraged to attend with someone from a partner agency (PA CareerLink® staff, parole/probation staff, mental health program staff, etc.) who works collaboratively with adult education staff to provide services to offenders and/or reentrants. All participants will be enrolled in the PA Adult Education Resources PD Portal (<https://pdportal.paadulthoodresources.org>) and will need to complete a pre-training assignment and download or print a virtual binder prior to the first webinar meeting. All course materials, including the virtual binder, assignment directions, webinar attendance tests, and the final course evaluation, are located in the PD Portal. Participants will be expected to complete an action plan on how they will implement material from the training. The action plan will be due one week after the last Zoom session. A facilitator is available to answer questions before, during, and after the training.
