


Understanding Rural Water Issues in Spokane County

This informational meeting will cover the background of water rights law and what led to the Supreme Court ruling known as the “Hirst” decision. We’ll explain the requirement placed on counties to manage groundwater withdrawals where prior water rights, including instream flow rights like in the **Little Spokane River watershed**, are protected by law. There will be an overview of how Spokane County has responded by developing a water bank and review of how water banks work.
