The James S. Black Memorial Scholarship is awarded annually to a deserving recipient selected by the Board of Directors of the James S. Black Memorial Scholarship Foundation.

Eligibility Requirement

The Scholarship recipient must be a member of the Spokane Association of REALTORS®, Washington Association of REALTORS® and National Association of REALTORS®, and be a full-time licensed real estate agent for a minimum of two years at the time of the application.

Selection Criteria

The criteria used to evaluate all applications are: 1) evidence that real estate is, and will be, a full-time career for the individual; 2) evidence of a desire to become a better REALTOR®; 3) involvement in promoting the professional image of REALTORS® evidenced by involvement in the real estate community extra curricular activities, etc.; 4) successful record in the real estate profession.

The Scholarship is to be used toward pursuit of a professional designation as established by the National Association of REALTORS®.

If you feel that you or one of your sales agents are qualified to receive this Scholarship, please submit the completed application and letter of recommendation to the SAR 1924 N. Ash Spokane, WA 99205.

The deadline for the submittal of the application is Friday, February 9, 2018. The Scholarship will be awarded at the March 15 Quarterly Membership Meeting at Centerplace Regional Events Center.

POLICY:

The James S. Black Memorial Scholarship Fund is sponsored by the Spokane Association of REALTORS® to help members pay for tuition and expenses for classes leading to professional designations as sanctioned by the National Association of REALTORS®, i.e. Graduate REALTORS® Institute, Certified Residential Broker, Certified Property Manager, Society of Industrial REALTORS®, or Member of the Appraisal Institute.

The James S. Black Memorial Scholarship Fund will be a self-perpetuating fund. The total amount to be given each year will be determined by the selection committee based on the dollars generated by the fund.

The scholarship or scholarships will be awarded on the basis of the following:

SELECTION CRITERIA:

- Evidence that real estate is and will be a full-time career for the individual;
- Evidence of a desire to become a better REALTOR®;
- Involvement in promoting the professional image of REALTORS® evidenced by involvement in the real estate community extra-curricular activities, etc.;
- Successful record in the real estate profession.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- A member of the National Association of REALTORS®;
- A member of the Washington Association of REALTORS®;
- A member of the Spokane Association of REALTORS®;
- A licensed real estate agent for a minimum of two (2) years at the time of the initial application;
- Shall not be a relative of any member of the Board of Directors serving at the time the recipient applies for a scholarship.
