During the special month of December we celebrate the birth of our Savior Jesus. Each family has its own special traditions. When I was growing up, my family roasted a pig on Christmas Eve, and enjoyed black beans and rice, salad, sweet plantains, with flan for dessert. We opened presents on Christmas Day and celebrated Jesus' birth by cutting a cake. What is your tradition? When you see me at church I would love it if you would share your tradition with me!

**The Children's Christmas Program**, an annual December favorite among parents, children, staff and congregation, will look a little different this year, due to present circumstances. ### December Themes:

**Christmas Gifts:** The children will create beautiful Christmas gifts for their parents.

**Christmas around the World:** We will discover the different ways people celebrate Christmas around the world. Did you know that Christmas in Mexico includes breaking a piñata, setting up a nativity scene, and baking a plastic baby in a cake to honor baby Jesus? Our children will make a piñata as they learn new traditions.

**Baby Jesus is born:** The children will make different crafts of baby Jesus.

**Happy New Year:** New Year's hats, noise makers, and a New Year's countdown ball are among the crafts we'll work on to ring in the New Year.

### December Bible Stories:

**Mary Meets an Angel:** Our teachers will explain to the children that God sent the angel Gabriel to deliver a special message to Mary. Gabriel told Mary that she would be the mother of the Son of God. What an honor! Mary was amazed that she was chosen by God to deliver the world's

most important baby, Jesus; she was very excited to be the Lord's servant. The children will learn that God can do anything and He is worthy of our trust. We must be willing to serve God with all our hearts.

**A Baby Named John:** Our teachers will explain how the angel Gabriel gave Zechariah the incredible news that his wife, Elizabeth, would give birth to a son who would become a great preacher. They would name their baby John. God had chosen them as the parents of a boy who would grow up and help others fol-

low God's own Son. We need to remember that God has a purpose for everyone.

**He's Here:** The children will learn about the Nativity. (Mary was blessed of God, her baby wrapped in swaddling clothes, animals surrounded the manger, and the Magi came to praise the new king.) They will discover that a manger, which served as a makeshift bed for Baby Jesus, is actually where cows and horses eat from.
