STEWARSHIP CORNER

The Lord spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to the people of Israel, saying: When anyone sins unintentionally in any of the Lord's commandments about things not to be done, and does any one of them: If the whole congregation

of Israel errs unintentionally and the matter escapes the notice of the assembly, and they do any one of the things that by the Lord's commandments ought not to be done and incurs guilt; when the sin that they have committed becomes known, the assembly shall offer a bull of the herd for a sin offering and bring it before the tent of the meeting. MISSION BOARD ACTIVITY

The Mission Board of Peace Lutheran met Sunday afternoon via Zoom. It was decided to use part of the funds in our restricted account for mission purposes. To help spread the gospel we are donating \$1,125 to the **LCMS Pakistan Mission** of Jay and Julie Dass. This money will purchase motorcycles to allow three Seminary students to enter slum areas not accessible by car. We are also giving \$1,000 to **Mission Nation Publishing** to cover the cost of their next audio book. To help people financially we will provide \$450 to LWML for their participation in the **RIP program** to pay off medical debt. Finally we agreed to participate in the **Christmas Shoe Box program** sponsored by Samaritan's Purse.
