## **KNN Board Update**

In July, the KNN Board engaged in discussions regarding the following key areas:

- Continued conversations to plan a series of virtual KNN discussions for faculty, staff and students targeted to begin as early as Fall 2020
- Discussed possible approaches for the KNN's presentation on July 30<sup>th</sup> as part of the
   Philanthropy Roundtable's Healthcare Workforce Strategy session. The session provides
   an opportunity to introduce a small group of funders to the KNN's work in caring and
   character and discuss strategies for improving the health workforce. The Philanthropy
   Roundtable Conference has been postponed to 2021.
- KNN Medical Professionalism effort is developing a paper exploring the role of medicine, public health and the need for a renewed social contract between medicine and society. A written summary of the proceedings of the February 2020 KNN Expert Advisory Council meeting on medical professionalism is available on request.
- August KNN Board Retreat- The KNN Board retreat will focus on character and caring.

On the evening of August 12<sup>th</sup>, the KNN Board will engage in a discussion with Marvin Berkowitz, PhD, Sanford N. McDonnell Endowed Professor of Character Education and Co-Director of the Center for Character and Citizenship at the University of Missouri-St. Louis on his work in the Center for Character and Citizenship and how the events of 2020 have influenced the national discussion on character.

On August 13<sup>th</sup>, the KNN Board will continue discussions to advance character and caring with presentations from the KNN Character and Caring groups.
