



In November of 2022, Community
Teamwork purchased and began renovating
a former rooming house on Summer Street
in Lowell for 19 new Permanent Supportive
Housing units for individuals experiencing
homelessness.

The 19 units will be efficiency apartments and each unit will contain its own bathroom and kitchenette. Residents will benefit from a permanent supportive housing model which will include addressing their broader needs including access to food, transportation, and healthcare. In addition, we will provide support in areas such as: access to employment, educational opportunities, financial literacy, help accessing state benefits, and legal support.

As often happens when renovating older buildings, the projected renovation costs have nearly doubled. We have been diligently working to obtain the resources to finish construction and we thank those who have already helped us secure just over half of the \$4.3 million needed to complete the project, but we still have a long way to go.

This is where you can help. Every gift can make a huge impact. For example, \$50 can supply new bedding for one shelter or housing unit; and \$250 can purchase one new bathroom vanity; or a \$1,000 gift can help pay for kitchen appliances at one of our housing sites.
