The Saving Bank Charitable Foundation Awards Community Teamwork Grant for New Women's Shelter

Lowell, MA, May 14, 2023 – Community Teamwork was one of several local nonprofit organizations that received a financial award from The Savings Bank Charitable Foundation. The foundation, established in 1997 through an initial endowment of \$550,000 from The Savings Bank, presented a total of \$67,768 to 23 nonprofit organizations during the 28th distribution of funds. Over the past 28 years, the Foundation has made donations in excess of \$1,017, 847 to organizations in local communities.

The award was presented by The Savings Bank Charitable Foundation to Community Teamwork's Heather Ciccarelli, Director of Planning and Quality Improvement, and Margot Reagan, Director of Development.

According to the foundation, awards were granted based on a number of factors, including intended use of the funds by the organization and the organization's status as a publicly supported charity. Organizations that received an award were located in the areas served by The Savings Bank, with a focus on those organizations serving the residents of Wakefield, Lynnfield, Andover, North Reading, and Methuen.

Community Teamwork will use the funds to support the creation and renovations of a first of its kind in the area, Women's Shelter.

"We are so grateful for the support from The Savings Bank Charitable Foundation which will strengthen our efforts to create an emergency shelter for up to 50 unhoused women with shelter, re-housing opportunities, case management and other wrap -around services from our organization, including financial education, energy and utilities assistance, and housing supports.", said Carl Howell, CEO, Community Teamwork.
