## Important Municipal Election Dates

September 8th-17th- Early Voting for the Primary Election

September 21st- Preliminary Election

October 20th-29th- Early Voting for the General Election

November 2nd- General Election

## Where Do I Vote?

Your polling location for the general election depends on what voting district and precinct you live in. You can find out what district you live in by going to [lowellma.gov/findmydistrict](https://www.lowellma.gov/findmydistrict). You can also verify your polling location by calling the Elections Office at 978-674-4046

## Can I Vote by Mail?

Yes. In 2021 elections all Massachusetts voters are eligible to vote by mail upon application, no explanation needed! You can get an application at:

To apply to vote by mail, complete a "vote by mail" application and return it by mail or in-person to the Elections & Census Office. Completed applications with an electronic signature can also be returned by e-mail to: [elections@lowellma.gov](mailto:elections@lowellma.gov).

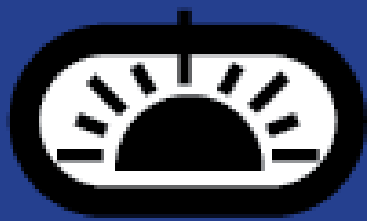
Make sure to apply as early as possible. The U.S. Postal Service recommends allowing up to 7 days for ballot delivery in each direction. Application's must reach the Election Office by the 4th business day before the election.

### Returning Your Ballot

Completed ballots may be returned by mail to the Elections & Census Office at 375 Merrimack Street Basement, Room 5 Lowell, MA 01852 or in person to City Hall. If you plan to return your ballot in person, there are two secure ballot boxes located at City Hall:

- Outside City Hall at entrance to JFK Plaza, adjacent to public notice board
- Outside City Hall at entrance on Merrimack Street, to the left of the steps

You may return you ballots at anytime before Election Day. Ballots must reach the Election & Census Office by the close of polls on Election Day in order to be counted.



# Can I Vote Early?

Yes. Early voting for the General Election will take place from October 20th-29th. Early voting for the Preliminary Election will take place from September 8th-17th. Only voting districts 2, 3, 4, 7 have Preliminary Elections for City Council- if you do not live in one of these four districts, you will not vote in the Preliminary. During early in-person voting times, voters do not need to vote at the precinct in their district but can vote at any location during this time period.
