



Are you a tenant behind on your rent because of COVID-19? Or a landlord whose tenants need help getting back on their feet? Then you may be able to take advantage of the Safe Harbor Housing Program.

- This is not a mandatory program, so both parties need to be in agreement.
- Parties must still respond in a timely manner to any notifications they received from the Court.
- If a tenant receives an Eviction Notice with a Court date, they must appear in Court, unless the Court confirms that the case is continued.
- If a tenant is interested, please contact your landlord.

Who qualifies?

Help is available for income-eligible tenants who are experiencing financial hardship because of the COVID-19 emergency and are at risk of eviction as a result. Landlords may initiate the application process on behalf of tenants who they believe to be eligible.

In order to receive assistance, tenants must meet the following criteria:

- The household earns at or below 80% of Area Median Income, adjusted for family size; and
- The household is in arrears because of financial hardship due to the COVID-19 emergency.
