HOUSE OF DELEGATES

The House of Delegates is the policy-making body of the Association and a pathway to an Executive Committee leadership position.

93 Total members. This includes 80 elected delegates, the elected officers, the immediate past president, five former past presidents, the Bar Journal Editor-in-Chief, and the RI delegates to the ABA HOD.

4 regular meetings per year, with occasional special meetings, held in hybrid format whenever possible.



EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The Executive Committee manages the affairs of the Association between meetings of the Association and of the HOD, and shall have authority to exercise all of the powers of the Association.

12 Total members, consisting of the elected officers, the immediate past President, the Editor-in-Chief of the Rhode Island Bar Journal and six members at large elected by the HOD.
