



OAK CREEK ASSEMBLY OF GOD MISSION HOUSE POLICY

Missions House Purpose:

Oak Creek Assembly of God has purchased a single-family residence for the exclusive use of missionaries who are home on furlough and/or itinerating. The house is kept fully furnished and in a condition that is ready for the missionary family to move in.

We endeavor to keep the house in a way that will make missionaries feel that the house is their home, rather than simply a place that they are visiting.

Resident Missionary Expectations:

- 1.The first and cardinal rule for the missionary family living in the house is to ENJOY AND BE AT HOME.
- 1.The house will be equipped with the items that the missionary family will need to move in and live during their furlough. Missionary families are welcome to personalize the home and arrange it in a manner in which they are most comfortable. Personal items, photos, etc. are encouraged.
- 1.Lawn mowing and snow removal will be provided by Oak Creek Assembly of God.
- 1.We anticipate that the house will experience normal wear and tear. The missionary will pay a \$500 damage deposit to the church. Half of the deposit is non-refundable and will be used to provide new bedding, towels, and other personal items. The remaining half of the deposit will be refunded upon departure if repairs are unnecessary.
- 1.The missionary will pay a monthly amount of \$700 (payable on the first of each month in the main office at OCAG) to offset the normal operating cost of the home. This will include electricity, gas, water, sewer, insurance, and maintenance. OCAG will be responsible to pay these bills, so as to

guarantee that there are no lapses in these services. The missionary will be responsible for paying their communication costs, such as cable TV, phone and internet and will communicate directly with the service provider.

- 1.The missionary should contact Pastor Tanto, executive pastor, at (414) 762-2010 with any needed repairs to the building, appliances, equipment, etc.
- 1.The missionary shall leave the house as found, with the exception of normal wear and tear.
- 1.The missionary shall not make any alterations to the house. Please do not paint or make large holes in the walls.
- 1.Oak Creek Assembly of God does not allow pets in the mission house.
- 1.The missionary will not have charges for use of the house except as listed above.
- 1.Oak Creek Assembly of God looks forward to the missionary family participating in the Church to the fullest extent possible, as long as it does not interfere with the main purpose of their furlough.
- 1.In the event that the missionary's furlough is extended beyond the date agreed upon, the executive pastor should be notified as soon as the extension is determined. Since the next residents will be notified well ahead of the move-in date, flexibility for departure date is limited. The more notice we have, the greater our options. An extension is not guaranteed.
- 1.We expect that the Missionary family living in the Missions House will take part in the community life of Oak Creek Assembly of God, considering it your home church during itineration. We request that when in town, the missionary and family commit to engaging in the following ways at Oak Creek:



- Attend Sunday services, kids' church, and other church events.
- Share at life group meetings/midweek classes upon availability and request.
- Pray for Oak Creek Assembly of God: its families, ministries, and community.
