

Sunday Dinner/ City on a Hill- Milwaukee

The new church planted at City on a Hill on January 19, 2020 has a congregation that is growing even in the midst of the pandemic. It is named *Sunday Dinner* because it uses the dinner church model, serving Sunday dinner as part of the worship service.

Before COVID-19, the church met in City on a Hill's large cafeteria, but since March the church has gone mobile, with teams of staff and volunteers preparing and delivering meals to members of the congregation, praying with them, meeting emergency needs for food and hygiene items, and helping them feel less isolated during a challenging time. The teams share the gospel on front porches and sometimes even break out in a worship song.

This outreach serves to keep the church connected and ministered to – and as people tell their family and friends, our congregation of adults and families has doubled from 70 to 140 in the past 4 months!
