Meal Pickup Days:

- Thursday, 4/9 - pick up meals for Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday and Monday (5 days).
- Tuesday, 4/14 - pick-up meals for Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday (3 days).
- Friday, 4/17 – pick up meals for Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday (4 days).
- Pickups will then continue on Tuesdays and Fridays for the duration of the school closure.

Locations: Connoquenessing Valley Elementary, Evans City Elementary/Evans City Middle School, Haine Elementary/Middle School, or the Seneca Valley Intermediate High School (SVIHS).

You may pick up meals for all eligible children in your family at one location. You do not need to pick up the meals at your child's assigned school.

If you have difficulty picking up meals at the schools, please complete the special considerations box on the form, including your phone number and a staff person will be in touch with you.

If you are currently unemployed, without income or your income status has changed, you may be eligible for meals through the National School Lunch Program. Please complete the application located on the food services page of the website at <https://www.svsd.net/Page/209>. The application may be completed online or on paper and returned to the food service department.

For those families who are part of the Full Table Project through Grace Community Church (GCC), bags will also be available for pickup from 10 a.m. – noon at any of our elementary/middle school buildings and the SVIHS beginning Wednesday, March 18. You may pick up bags for all eligible children in your family at one location
