

RE-OPENING LADUE CHAPEL

The following protocols are a work in progress and will be evolving as we explore best practices.

What to Expect for Worship at Ladue Chapel Presbyterian Church

- An email will go out each Monday with a registration link for the following Sunday's worship.
 - If you need assistance making a reservation, please call the church office; 314-993-4771.
- The Sanctuary and Fireside will be available for those who reserve seats ahead of time.
 - Sanctuary will accommodate up to 100 people.
 - Fireside will accommodate up to 25 people.
- Fellowship Hall will be available for those who have not made a reservation- with capacity up to 50 people.
- There will be one worship service at 10:30am.
- Worship will also be live streamed.
- During worship, the first five pews on the pulpit side will be unavailable to allow the pastor who is preaching to remove their mask during the sermon.
- Worshipers will be required to wear masks at all times; extra masks will be available.
- All worship spaces will be pre-cleaned prior to Sunday worship.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be placed throughout the building.
- In preparation for returning to worship in the sanctuary-an Ionization air filtration system has been installed.

Entering the Building

- One door will be open at the circle drive for check-in.
 - In case of rain, the check-in line will form in the Gathering Place.
- There will be temperature checks at check-in with a touchless thermometer.
 - For worshipers with ambulatory challenges, check-in will be available at the accessible entrance on the west side of the building facing Clayton Road (same procedure).

Sanctuary / Worship / Overflow

- Upon entry, ushers will lead people to their assigned seat using the e-ticket from Thundertix.
- Bulletins will be placed in assigned seats.
- Worship materials (hymnals, bibles, offering envelopes) will be available in pews.
- The offering will be received using two boxes placed in the sanctuary and hallway.
- Congregational singing will be allowed while wearing a mask.
- Children will remain seated with their parents during children's time.
- On communion Sundays, the elements will be provided and placed in assigned seats.
- For the safety of all, please keep your mask on at all times while in the building. Masks need to cover both nose and mouth.

Exiting the Building

- Ushers will dismiss worshipers pew by pew.
- Worshipers with ambulatory issues will exit first.
- Please observe social distancing as you exit
- Worshipers will exit through the same door they entered the building.
- There will be no indoor fellowship time but worshipers are encouraged to greet each other outside.
- The pastors will greet people outside in the Circle Drive (weather permitting).
