Ask your students to create a page for your school’s I Love to Read book. In 2017, Kyffin Elementary students entered a school wide contest and created the Kyffin I Love to Read book. When students create a page for their school’s book this benefits students and your school. Students will begin brainstorming about why reading is so important to them.

#### **Writing & Art Criteria for Contest**

Please have your students complete the following statement:

**I love to read \_\_\_\_\_ and then create an illustration to go along with their statement.**

*\*Criteria is to please place the illustration on a 8 X 11 normal sheet of paper with only one statement that explains why they love to read.*

We are inviting all grade levels to participate in this contest. Teachers if you can choose 5 students from your class that you believe have shown you their passion for why they **Love to Read with the above criteria**. From those 5 winners, a committee will choose one student's work from each classroom to go on to be entered in the Jefferson County wide contest. A final book will be selected by the committee. **Winners for the final Jefferson County ebook will be awarded a Barnes & Noble Gift Card for their "I Love to Read" statement and illustration! The winning school will receive an ENC donation and the ebook will be posted on the ENC website.** Additional information concerning future publication will be submitted to the student and their parents after the winning entries are selected.
