Greetings! It has been so long since we've done an actual Run that we hardly know where to begin. Suffice it to say we are doing a Run and we need your help for it to be a success. What better way for you to start your summer off right than to make a difference in the lives of many who need our help? The Midnight Run has been the cornerstone of FUSW's social action activities for decades and it will be great to resume this good work.

We've spoken with the Run office to see how other groups have gone about Breakfast Runs recently, and happily they tell us that while some groups are doing pre-prepared bags most are doing the buffet lines that we've done in the past without any issues at all, and that is probably the easiest way for us to get back into the swing of things.

We need a team to prepare for the Run at FUSW on the morning of the 27th but most importantly we will need a solid team to go into the city to set up and serve. If you can help us in either way that would be great. As in the past we will meet at FUSW by 7am to prep and then head into the city. Here are the food and drink items that we will need:

- 15 doz fresh eggs NOT HARD BOILED
- 70 bagels
- 220 links of turkey sausage
- butter for cooking and for some of the bagels
- pastries for 80 (small danish, donuts, etc.)
- soft fruit for 70
- 80 water bottles
- 6 half gallons of orange juice
- 1 gallon whole milk
- cream cheese for 60 bagels
- ketchup for the eggs

We also can use underwear and socks, new not used, boxers or colors preferred over whites, with sizes M, L and XL most needed. It's been so long since we did a Run that honestly we don't know what our toiletries supplies look like, but if you have any travel size soaps, shampoos, deodorants, lotions, razors, toothbrushes, toothpaste, we will gratefully take them and we are sure they will get used soon.
