Policies and Other considerations

Good Shepherd Project Restore Policies:

For the safety and enjoyment of everyone, we ask that you please adhere to our policies and basic rules of project restore. Thank you, in advance for sharing these with your group ahead of time.

- Please stay in the gym area and attached lobby area outside gym (or designated area), when staying on campus
- Youth (under 19) are not allowed in the kitchen area except in specific circumstances
- NO males on the female side of housing and NO females on the male side of housing (no exceptions)
- Please only shower during designated shower times. Showers will be limited to 15 min or less for each person
- No drinking on or off campus and no alcohol or smoking allowed on campus.

- MODESTY CLAUSE:

- We are called to live a life worthy of the calling we have received as beloved children of God. That means in word, deed, action (dress code). We ask that no undergarments be seen and that shorts, shirts, and skirts are of appropriate length.
- Understand that every group will be asked to assist with daily chores to help keep the facility looking nice and ready for the next group. Be respectful of the facility in its care and usage. If damage occurs, report it immediately and know that you may be responsible for the cost of repair.

Other safety considerations:

- 1. Please do not wander away from your group and make them aware if you are going somewhere, especially when you are on the jobsite.
- 2. While Fremont is relatively safe and so is our facility, we suggest that youth do not go anywhere alone and that adult leaders know where their youth are at all times.
- 3. Each day you will have safety and sensitivity training.
- 4. Be sensitive to the fact that people are allowing you in their homes. Be respectful and careful about what you say and consider that pictures may not be advisable while on the worksite
- 5. Hydration (drinking water) will be tremendously important while on the job site, but also after you are done for the day. Sunscreen may also be an important consideration if you are working outside.
- 6. Watch out for each other, care for each other, and have the servant heart and mind of Jesus when it comes to how you treat all people.
