IF YOUR CHURCH RECEIVED A (PPP) LOAN, NOW YOU ASK FOR LOAN FORGIVENESS

If your church received a PPP Loan, the next step is to apply to your bank for forgiveness of the loan amount. Your bank should provide the application and guidance for this process. We have been given 24 weeks in which to spend the PPP Loan on approved expenses (payroll, utilities, etc.) instead of the original 8 weeks, so we should all be eligible to have 100% of our loan forgiven.
