□ Be willing to learn new skills and take risks in leadership roles

TPYC will typically meet at least once a month at different locations throughout the Presbytery. Some meetings may also be online or hybrid. Attendance at these meetings and other TPYC functions are crucial for a healthy Youth Council. Extra meetings are sometimes called as the need arises. Transportation to the meetings and events are the responsibility of the youth member.

The Trinity Presbytery Youth Council is responsible for:

- Planning and implementing weekend retreats, rally days and service projects
- Planning Presbytery wide youth events so they are balanced in worship, recreation, fellowship, and study.
- Promoting Presbytery and General Assembly opportunities for youth participation from all churches in our presbytery
- Serve as liaisons between the Presbytery office and churches of the presbytery for promotion of youth events and communications in general
