BUDGETED BENEVOLENCES

Those benevolences which can be used to fund the mission budgets of the Presbytery, Synod and General Assembly.

These benevolences are credited against the church's benevolence acceptance.

- A. Tithe/Unified Giving** - These undesignated funds support the annual Mission Budget and administrative expenses of Presbytery.
- B. Per Capita Apportionment** - This is used to fund the administrative expenses of the General Assembly, Synod, and Trinity Presbytery.

NON-BUDGETED BENEVOLENCES

Those benevolences which are used to support specifically named causes which are over and above the mission budgets of the Presbytery, Synod and General Assembly.

- A. Special Offerings** - These gifts are for causes which have been approved by the Presbytery, Synod or General Assembly.
 - (1) One Great Hour of Sharing - This offering is used to alleviate hunger and provide emergency aid to those in need around the world.
 - (2) Pentecost - This offering helps to support children at risk and programs dealing with youth and adults.
 - (3) Peace & Global Witness - This offering is used to support peacemaking efforts throughout the church.
 - (4) Christmas Joy Gift - This offering is used to provide financial assistance to current and former church workers and their families, as well as providing financial assistance to students attending Presbyterian-related racial ethnic colleges and schools.
 - (5) Father's Day Offering - This offering provides general financial support for Migrant/Hispanic Ministry in Trinity Presbytery.
 - (6) South Sudan Partnership- Gifts support the ministry of Trinity Presbytery in South Sudan.
- B. Selected Giving** - These funds are forwarded to PCUSA to support specific items, as specified by the donor. These include Mission Co-Worker Support, PCUSA Special Projects, and Presbyterian Disaster Assistance. Name and Account number should be specified.
