## STUDENT SELECTION

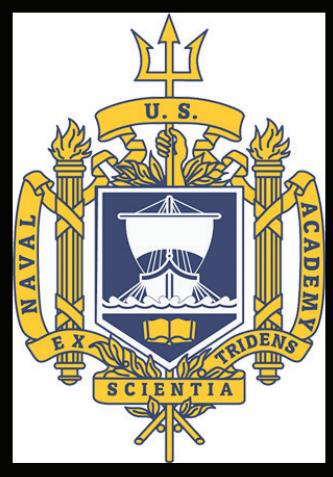
- Students must be entering 9th-11th grade in the following school year.

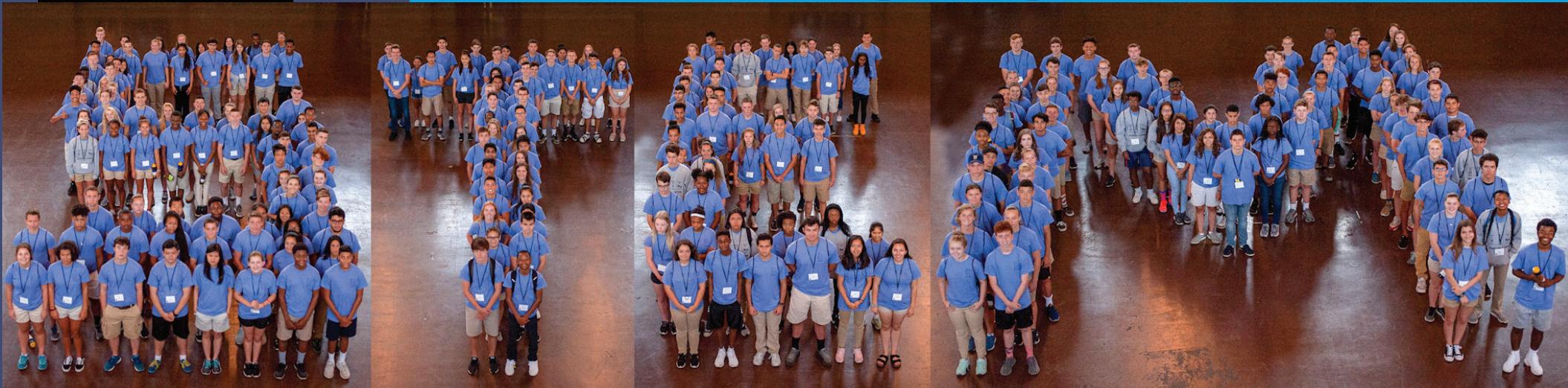
## PROGRAM TUITION & TRAVEL EXPENSES

- The tuition to attend a session is \$550. Some scholarships are available based on financial need.
- Local campers will be responsible for arranging transportation to and from the Naval Academy.
- Out-of-area campers will be responsible for arranging transportation to and from Baltimore-Washington International Airport (BWI). Once you arrive, buses and midshipmen will be on-hand to transport campers from BWI to the Naval Academy in Annapolis and back to BWI upon program completion.
- Commercial air travelers should arrive at BWI between 9:00 am and 3:30 pm on Day 1 of the program, and depart no earlier than 3:00pm on the last day of the program.
