Important Orientation Week Notes:

School Hours (7:55am-2:15pm)

We will begin each school day ***five minutes earlier*** (7:55am) and dismiss ***fifteen minutes later*** (2:15pm). This additional instruction time will be distributed throughout the school day. We will follow the same school schedule as last year (with “X” as a fixed morning period) but the times will be adjusted.

Transportation

Drop-off and pick-up zones are established behind the gym to ease traffic flow. Please use all three lanes and pull as far forward as possible to drop-off your student. The drop-off / pick-up zone is available from 7:00-7:55am, 1:30-2:30pm and 11:30am-12:30pm on early dismissal days. Parents can help alleviate traffic congestion at the end of the day by picking up students 15 to 20 minutes *after* dismissal. ***The faculty parking lot and the front circle may not be used for drop-off or pick-up.***

PlusPortal grade reporting will allow parents to see current grades, missing assignments, progress reports, and report cards. If you prefer to receive paper copies of letters and report cards, please call the Main Office.
