3 Ways to Pay Tuition

Please note:

- Totals calculated based on 2017-2018 tuition costs *without* financial aid or scholarship.

1-Time Payment Due: June	\$15,400
Payment by Semester Due: June & December	\$7,700 per semester
Monthly Payments using Union Savings Bank Loan (4.25% interest) Due: Monthly	\$1,429.93 per month for 11 months (June to April)

{ Other Costs to Consider }

iPad approx. \$420*All students are required to have an iPad daily. *If you already own an iPad, you do not need to purchase another!

Uniform approx. \$200*All students are required to wear the proper SJ uniform daily. *Donated uniforms are available to help defray this expense.

2 Types of Aid: Scholarship & Financial Aid



Scholarship (Merit-Based Award)

St Joseph High School offers several academic scholarships to incoming students. To be eligible for these scholarships, prospective students must take either the first or second entrance exam (October 28 or November 11) and place in the 90th percentile and above. Scholarship recipients are notified via their acceptance letter and are invited to a scholarship reception in January. There are three categories of merit-based awards:



The Presidential Scholarship is a four-year, half-tuition scholarship offered to entering eighth grade students who score 98% or above on the entrance exam, and have the academic record and teacher recommendations reflective of their high scholastic ability.



The Principal's Scholarship is a \$16,000 award over four years (\$4,000 per year) and is awarded to those students who score between 94–97% on the entrance exam, and have the academic record and teacher recommendations reflective of their high scholastic ability.



The Cadet Scholarship is a \$12,000 award over four years (\$3,000 per year) and is awarded to those students who score between 90-93% on the entrance exam, and have the academic record and teacher recommendations reflective of their high scholastic ability.

These awards are renewed each year, provided the student maintains a cumulative academic average of 90% or better, and maintains a positive and responsible presence within the St Joseph community.



Financial Aid (Need-Based Aid)

The Financial Aid Committee reviews and distributes financial aid for new student applicants based on financial need. The Financial Aid process is optional. In order to be considered for financial aid, you must file and complete a FACTS application by the deadline (November 13, 2017). If completed after the deadline, financial aid is not guaranteed.



Financial Aid Application Process for New Students

The 2018-2019 FACTS online application is available now for new applicants.

- To complete the form, you will need your 2016 tax documents.
- Freshman applicants must complete FACTS application by **November 13, 2017**.
- You will be notified of your financial aid award (if applicable) in December along with your acceptance letter.
- Please note: Students requesting Financial Aid must reapply each year.
