

How to Make DIY Bubble Wands with cookie cutter shapes

Cookie Cutter Bubble Wands – Supplies:

- pipe cleaners
- colorful beads
- cookie cutters shapes
- scissors

Shaped Bubble Wands – Instructions:

1. If you use small cookie cutter shapes for your DIY bubble wands, you'll need one pipe cleaner per bubble wand. Start by wrapping the pipe cleaner around the cookie cutter, forming the shape of the cookie cutter. When you reach the end of the shape wrap the remaining pipe cleaner section around the shape a few times to close it shut. Then the remaining excess of the pipe cleaner becomes the handle for your bubble wand.



2. Thread the bubble wand handle with colorful beads. When you reach the bottom of the pipe cleaner with your beads, fold the pipe cleaner end up to secure the beads in place. We like to bunch the pipe cleaner up into a little ball on the end after bending it up to help it stay sealed shut.

3. If you use larger cookie cutters, plan for two pipe cleaners per DIY bubble wand. Mold the first pipe cleaner around the cookie cutter to form the shape. Connect the ends together to close it shut by wrapping the pipe cleaner around itself a few times. Then cut off any excess pipe cleaner piece with your scissors.

4. Fill the second pipe cleaner about half way full of beads. Bend the end of the pipe cleaner up to keep the beads in place. Then wrap the other end of the pipe cleaner around the pipe cleaner shape a few times to connect the two pieces together. Cut off any excess pipe cleaner with your scissors.

DIY Bubble Shooter

This Do It Yourself Bubble Shooter is so easy to make that any home without bubble wands will probably never have to buy another bubble wand again!

To make your do it yourself bubble shooter, you'll need 2 basic supplies that you probably already have in your home: some straws and rubber bands. That's it!

Take a bunch of straws and attach them together by wrapping them with a rubber band. If you don't have rubber bands within easy reach, don't worry. Just use some masking tape or sticky tape to join the straws together.

You can also cut the straws to a shorter length; this may be very useful if you don't have many straws but have many children to entertain.

Mix up a batch of bubble solution, (we love an easy DIY baby bath bubble solution – 1 part solution to 1 part water), and blow away.



This play is really satisfying for children as they make lots of bubbles with each breath. What fun!

How to Make Your Own Bubble Blower

What you need:

Ingredients

- Plastic Cup
- Plastic Straw
- Water
- Soap

Instructions

1. Poke a small hole in your plastic cup. This needs to be big enough to stick your straw into.
2. Pour 1/2 part water and 1/2 soap into the bottom of your cup. You don't need very much. In total, it will be about an inch. Make sure your liquid is lower than your hole.
3. Stick your straw into your cup; tilt your straw so it is into the bubble liquid and BLOW!!
