DCRC Blog Writing Guidelines

Audience

The primary audience for the *DCRC Blog* consists of professionals working in child-serving settings and the parents/families of those they serve. More specifically, the audience consists of all the caring adults in the lives of infants, toddlers and preschoolers.

Writing Guidelines

The *DCRC Blog* welcomes submissions focused on:

- Current dialogue around early childhood education, social-emotional health and resilience, including dialogue specific to your local community
- Success stories from programs and centers utilizing the Devereux Early Childhood Assessment (DECA) Program suite of resources
- Research outcomes and results on use of the DECA Program, or on use of other DCRC tools, such as the Devereux Adult Resilience Survey (DARS)

Formatting:

- For your idea submission – Ideas/topics for review must be sent to Rudee Abello at rabello@devereux.org. In your email, please include: name of your organization/program, city and state. Present the main topic of your submission, along with 4-6 bullet points that outline your proposed piece.
- For your article submission, once DCRC-approved
 - Must be between 500 and 1500 words
 - Photos, graphs and charts may be included
 - Use as simple and straightforward language as possible
 - Include some of yourself/your personality in your writing
- *Note: All accepted submissions are subject to editing and design. We will work with you to ensure you agree with any changes or revisions.*
