



## NC DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES

The North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (NCDHHS) has issued guidance on infection control measures (see attached) all facilities should take to limit and control COVID-19 infection, including the proper use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).

NCDHHS, in coordination with North Carolina Emergency Management (NCEM) and the National Guard (NCNG) will be distributing packs of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to long-term care facilities across the state to help ensure they can meet this guidance.

Each pack will include approximately **14-days** worth of:

- Face shields
- Procedure masks
- Gloves
- Shoe covers
