


Face Shield FAQ

What Is It?

Who Is Making the Face Shields?

The face shields are being made by Robb Dravis' team at [Biobubble Inc.](#) Biobubble creates custom clean rooms and contained environments for labs and research facilities.

Cleaning & Re-Use

The face shields react well to alcohol (71%) and Clorox wipes. The vision isn't restricted at all with the use of these products. However, these aren't medical grade. They are a homemade replacement for standard PPE. It is up to the user to determine how the safest and best way to use them.

Costs

The only costs are for shipping. The intention is not to charge for the masks unless there is a need to scale up, which might change that.
