Hope Centers Opportunities:

We operate four Hope Centers in the Cy-Fair community. Our Hope Centers offer kids a safe place to come after school where they can participate in crafts, cooking, art, reading, homework help and tutoring. The four Hope Centers are located in four different communities, one in a trailer park and three in apartment complexes. Our Hope Centers are open every week and from time to time we also host field trips and special events.

Volunteers should help the Hope Center interns and other volunteers with educational time, crafts, snack, games and recreational activities. They will encourage the kids to complete their homework and participate in educational activities. Their main purpose is to serve as a positive role model for the kids at the Hope Center.

Additionally, groups can organize Serve Days to do a preplanned activity at one of the Hope Centers. A wish list of items that are regularly needed are posted on the link below for donation drives and collections.

Hope Center volunteers must commit to serving at least twice per month, at least one hour per visit, and for a minimum of six months. Backpack Feeding Program

In an effort to prevent childhood hunger and to provide each child the opportunity to succeed in school and life, Cy-Hope has partnered with the Houston Food Bank to bring the Backpack Program to Cy-Fair ISD. Each week during the school year, students enrolled in this program receive a backpack of food that will help sustain them through the weekends when school food is not accessible. We currently serve 69 schools, which includes 1,500 children.

- School year: Deliver food to schools (Wednesdays or Thursdays)

- School year: Load cars delivering to schools (Wednesdays)
- Substitute drivers needed to cover occasionally for regular drivers
- Food baggers needed to assemble food bags (Mondays)

Ambassadors of Compassion (AOC)

Cy-Hope helps equip at-risk students for life via the Ambassadors of Compassion (AOC) Program. This program provides youth the opportunity to personally examine and "experience" life-ready principles in a small group discussion setting with other youth led by a Team Coach.

The AOC's **L.I.F.E.** program is built upon principles that every youth needs to master in order to lead a successful and fulfilling life:

- **L - LABOR** (Understanding the role that labor plays in our lives, recognizing the needs of others and the needs within our community, and taking action to help)
- **I - INFLUENCE** (Recognizing that we are influenced both positively and negatively by the culture and people around us, and acknowledging that we ourselves influence others)
- **F - FORGIVENESS** (Discovering that forgiveness is a process, and understanding and experiencing the freedom and power that comes from forgiving others, forgiving ourselves, and also asking for forgiveness when we offend others)
- **E - EXPERIENCES** (Exploring the importance of building on our life experiences and those of others, and facing and letting go of any negative experiences in order to help us reach our goals and dreams and full potential in life)
- Cy-Hope implements this workbook- and video-based mentoring program during a school class period once per week. AOC website to learn more about Ambassadors of Compassion.
