## **Curriculum Update**

- *Technology* – Mrs. Gina Quinn will be Director of Innovation and In-house Tech support in addition to teaching Social Studies for Grades 6,7 & 8. Mrs. Quinn will partner with Ms. Joan Williams, Technology and STEM expert at the Diocese of Bridgeport. Ms. Williams comes with extensive experience working in schools from teaching to administration to coaching with a focus on STEM and technology integration. She's already started this summer by giving

guidance on our Innovation Zones and supporting teachers with technology issues.

- *Innovation Lab* – Every grade level will have class time in the Innovation Lab with Mrs. Quinn. Through a grant from the Diocese, additional equipment (including a 3D printer and Green Screen) costing approximately \$10,000 will be available by the end of September.
- *Google Suite* – will be implemented across all grade levels for assignments.
- *Chromebooks for 6th Grade* – Phasing out individual devices and offering In- house Chromebooks for all 6th grade students.
- *Infrastructure upgrade in place* – WIFI, phone, PA, and security camera upgrades fully engaged for enhanced safety and learning. We are thankful to Monsignor Bob, the Diocese and our HSA for covering the \$125,000 cost of this most important project.
- *Progress reports* – to keep parents informed we are reinstating monthly progress reports in addition to quarterly report cards.
- *PE Class* – Grades K-4 will have PE 2x/week; grades 5-8 will have one extra PE class every other week (alternate with Innovation Lab)

- *Weekly Friday Newsletter* – Will remain primary vehicle of communication; format is being altered to be more succinct with links for additional information.
- *E-mail Blasts* – Mrs. Wong will continue to use these for important and immediate information distribution.
- *Appointments with Mr. Gjoka and Mrs. Bokuniewicz* – please email Mrs. Wong to set appointments. Our goal is to reserve meeting time, as much as possible, to before and after school hours. This is the same for email responses. Of course, there will be exceptions for special circumstances. Thank you.

## Events/Fundraisers – Closing the GAP

As you know, there is an \$1,881 Gap between the cost of tuition and the actual cost of educating every student.

The cost of educating one student minus the rate of tuition for one student: **\$8,226 - \$6,345 = \$1,881 GAP**

We are committed to keeping tuition increases to a minimum so there is a need to fill this GAP in other ways. This year we will roll out the Blooms Fund, which is an account that is used by the school to cover a range of expenses including operational, curriculum enhancements, professional development, technology upgrades – essentially everything that is key to keeping St. Rose School current and viable. We are counting on all St. Rose families to support the Blooms Fund during the year; no donation is too small. Help get the word out to family and friends whose support is critical to our strong future. We will reveal more details at Back to School Night.
