Dear Parents, Faculty and Staff,

As a follow up to the announcement I made at the State of the School/HSA Meeting on November 8th, I am delighted to share with you that the Diocese has approved our Infrastructure project. It is slated to begin the week of December 17th and will entail the following:

1. Complete upgrade of the WIFI system in both buildings.
2. New phone system with phones in every classroom and all offices.
3. New PA system.
4. Upgrade of the current security camera system enabling remote access to school administration and the police. Additional cameras will be added at a later date (funds TBD).
5. New wiring for all classroom doors to be used with keyless entry. Phase II of the project will be the purchasing and installation of the actual locks and electronic keys. Plans for funding and a projected date for Phase II will be announced at a later time.

This is phenomenal news for St. Rose School, putting us on the cutting edge of infrastructure technology and ensuring high quality security measures throughout the school buildings. We are currently the only school in the Diocese to implement all five upgrades at one time.

Please be assured that there will be no disruption to the school day when the work unfolds. A team from Frontier communications who are Virtus trained and background checked will handle the project from start to finish. This same team just completed a wiring job at Stamford Academy.

We are most grateful to Dr. Cheeseman and Monsignor Bob for sponsoring portions of this project. It is truly a blessing and puts us in strong standing for the future.

I will keep you posted as the project unfolds.
