Greetings 5th Grade Parents,

Reading: - We have been reading and discussing our new novel in class. We have also been working in groups in our packets. Next week we will do literary circles.

Students should also continue to read their AR books at home and complete their reading logs that are due on Friday.

Please encourage your children to read at least 20 minutes every night. Thank you for your help and support in this matter.

Vocabulary - This past week I did not assign vocabulary. We will work on Unit 9 in the Vocabulary book.

Spelling: This past week I gave the children a break from spelling. The spelling words next week will be the words from the List 10. They will get the list on Monday.
