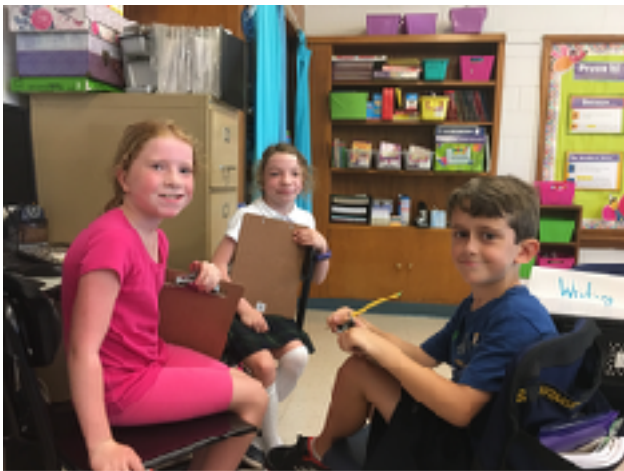


Third Grade
